### Writer's Workshop

Grades 3-4

The Writer's Workshop format includes story planning, revision, teacher editing, peer conferencing, and direct instruction in the mechanics of writing. As we work through the writing process, students are challenged to expand their ideas, to create focus within a topic, and to have fun expressing themselves! Writer's Workshop is designed to emphasize the act of writing itself—students spend most of their time putting pencil to paper, not just learning about it. Over time, students learn to choose their own topics and to manage their own development as they work through a wide variety of writing projects in a sustained and self-directed way. All writing will take place in class with no required home assignments. While the focus for composition in the Language Arts core classes is to teach specific form and style, this class exists to first and foremost build an enthusiasm and love for writing. Form and style will be taught but in an indirect method as the focus will be on helping students to develop fluency in writing. Course offered contingent on enrollment.

Grades 3-4

Developed at MIT, the Mindstorms are one of the best teaching tools available to children for programming and engineering concepts. Designed to inspire and motivate children to learn the principles of working machines, these state-of-the-art robots feature ultrasonic sensors, servo motors, Bluetooth technology, and more! By utilizing computer programming, children learn to manipulate the actions and behaviors of their robotic creation, even making one robot communicate a command to another robot!

iKids Robotics offers an opportunity for your child to explore the fundamentals of engineering and computer programming while incorporating important skills in technology, design, mathematics, and science. This program not only sparks creativity

Grades 1-4

Cost: \$200

Cost: \$150 semester per hour; after school on Fridays 2:30-3:00 is \$75

**Music**

Grades K-4

Cost: \$75

Music students will have an opportunity to experience an active involvement in exploring the fun of music and singing, music games, and group activities will be used to lay a foundation in basic music theory. Additionally, students will learn the elements of music and connect to different music styles through singing, playing instruments, creative movement, reading music, and listening. Students will also be introduced to composers

**Physical Education**

Grades K-4

Cost: \$75
